| <p>Health Insurance</p> | <p>All students in Germany must be covered by a health insurance. When enrolling as a student at HTW Dresden, they must provide a proof of health insurance.</p> <p>Students from countries within the European Union (EU)/EFTA must apply for the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) in their native country and take it to Germany.</p> <p>Students from countries that do not belong to the European Union (EU)/EFTA must be insured immediately by a German statutory health insurance company (e.g. AOK, TK, Barmer...) after arrival. | <p>Visa</p> | <p>Students from countries in the European Union, EFTA, Australia, Israel, Japan, Canada, Korea, New Zealand, Taiwan, Costa Rica, Malaysia, Brasil, Chile and the USA do not require a visa to enter Germany. A valid passport or personal identification is sufficient.</p> <p>Students from countries that are not in the European Union or EFTA require a study visa for their stay in Germany for academic purposes. Visa applications are to be submitted to the German Missions Office in their home country.</p> <p>All Students from non-EU countries who stay longer than three months are obliged to apply for a residency permit for academic purposes at the Immigration Authority of Dresden within the first three months after entering Germany.</p> |
