

## Erasmus+ Student Guidebook Academic year: 2021-2022

**Autumn semester:** End of September/beginning of October 2021 – February 2022 (exact dates will be advised);

**Winter holiday:** end of December 2021 – beginning of January 2022 (exact dates will be advised);

### **Arrival:**

Recommendations for arrival: few days before the semester starts.

When you arrive in Sibiu your buddy will wait for you at the bus, train station or at the airport and help you get to the Dorm; After this he/she will show you where to find an exchange office, the best shops, hospital and other useful places.

### **Classes:**

You will be announced by email about the date and time when you can meet your Erasmus+ coordinator in order to discuss about your learning agreement, timetable, etc. This meeting will take place in the first part of your mobility.

### **Accommodation:**

International students will be accommodated in Dormitory number 3, situated on Victoriei Blvd. no.31. Before your arrival in Sibiu you will receive a registration form to be filled in with your room option.

The Dorm has:

- Single rooms ⇒150 Euros
- Double rooms⇒90 Euro

The rooms have private bathrooms and are equipped with bed sheets and blankets therefore you only need to bring your own towels, plates, pans, cutlery, etc. or buy them from here.

*Information: In case the number of students overpasses the capacity of the Dorm, students need to find accommodation on their own!*



### **Laundry:**

The laundry is located at the basement of the dormitory and is open daily between 8 a.m and 9 p.m. Detergent and clothes balsam are provided for a min.fee - about 0,50-0,75 Cents

The bed sheets are collected every Wednesday by the staff of the Dorm in order to be washed.

### **Internet:**

At your arrival at LBUS you will receive an application form that needs to be completed from LBUS network (you can use the computers in the library or in the International Office). About 5 days after completing this form, you will receive a personal ID and password. By using these you will have free access to Eduroam network in all the buildings of the university.

### **Canteen:**

The canteen is situated at a 2 minutes walking distance from Dorm 3 and it is opened from Monday to Friday, 12 p.m. to 8 p.m. The lunch menu (soup + main dish + sweet) costs 10 lei (2.5 Euros).

### **Bus station:**

The closest bus station is located at 5 minutes-walking distance from the Dorm.

### **Other facilities:**

Supermarket, copy centers, pharmacy, gym, swimming center, park are situated at a 3 minutes walking-distance from the Dorm.

### **Library:**

The library of Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu is situated close to the city center and the access of Erasmus students is based on the student card issued by the library

### **Medical assistance:**

You can benefit of medical assistance every day from Monday to Friday, 8 a.m to 7p.m in Dormitory no.2, close to Dormitory no.3.  
Dentistry is situated in Dormitory no. 1.



## Visa

For EU students visa is not required. Please have with you your ID and Insurance card in order to apply for the permit of residence.

For Non-Eu students passport and visa plus insurance card is required in order to apply for the permit of residence.

All the formalities will be processed together with the staff from the International Relations Office soon after your arrival.
